3. Purpose and legal basis of personal data processing

Users log in to the system in order to execute reporting in accordance with the Act on the Bank of Finland and the AnaCredit Regulation.

(Bank of Finland)

Users log in to the system in order to execute reporting required by Article 26 of the Regulation on Markets in Financial Instruments (EU) No 600/2014 (MiFIR). (Financial Supervisory Authority)

In connection with the implementation of the service, personal data is processed in the manner required by personal data legislation. A prerequisite for using the service is the provision and maintenance of contact information. Electronic contact information is stored in a register maintained by Posti Messaging Oy and may be utilised in the Bank of Finland's official communications.

The personal data in the register are processed for the following purposes:

Service provision

Maintaining the Data Collection Service 2 reporting portal maintained by Posti Messaging Oy as well as production, such as tasks connected with the management of reporting, including customer identification, management of access rights, verification and authentication of reporting events,

sending of feedback reports and investigation of errors.

Development of services and activities

- Planning and development of services, activities and information systems
- Management and quality assurance of services and activities.

Customer relationship management and customer service

- Management and development of customer and stakeholder relationships
- Customer guidance, and implementation and development of customer service.

Information security

- Ensuring the accessibility, integrity and reliability of services and data

4. Categories of data subjects and personal data

Categories of data subjects:

- User data of reporting service users

Categories of personal data

- The data on reporting service users include personal data such as personal identification numbers, contact information, company names, company identification codes and log data concerning the use of the service

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5. Recipients of personal data and categories of recipients

The Bank of Finland and the Financial Supervisory Authority may disclose personal data in a manner specified by the requirements of the competent authorities or other parties, based on the legislation in force at the time in question.

6. Information on the possible transfer of personal data to a third country or international organisation

Data are not transferred outside the EU or the EEA or to international organisations.

7. Retention period for personal data or criteria for determining this period

Personal data are retained for as long as a person has access rights to the system. Data are erased when the access rights are terminated.

8. General description of technical and organisational security measures

In order to protect personal data against unauthorised access, disclosure, destruction or other unlawful handling, appropriate technical and organisational security measures are used, taking potential risks into consideration. These measures include the use of secure equipment premises and administrative and technical information security solutions.

9. Rights of data subjects

Data subjects in the register have the right:

- to request from the controller access to personal data concerning them and the restriction or erasure of such data or to object to processing as well as the right to transfer data from one system to another.
- to lodge a complaint about the processing of data to the supervising authority.

10. Statutory or contractual requirement to provide data and consequences of failure to provide such data

If a user does not provide information necessary for registration, the user cannot use the service.

11. Source of information

Personal identification numbers obtained via the Suomi.fi service are combined with user data.
